City Clerk Stein stated the proposed resolution would formally adopt the official final election results submitted by the Mohave County Elections Department for the August 26, 2014 primary election in Bullhead City.

2. Discussion and possible action to approve the renaming of Loop Road within Rotary Park as "Bella's Way." (Public Works Director Agrawal)

Public Works Director Agrawal stated following last week's tragic events, there was some discussion regarding the possibility of naming a city facility in remembrance of Bella. He said staff determined that Loop Road, a half-mile stretch of road running through Rotary Park, was currently unnamed and would be an appropriate location for re-naming. He said the City Code provides for such a procedure which allowed the Council to consider naming a facility after an appropriate time. City Attorney Emery stated the decision would be legally sufficient within the City's administrative code and regulations.

Vice Mayor Duvall asked if naming a tree or other things in Rotary Park were in addition to naming the street. City Manager Cotter stated other things would be in addition to the re-naming of the street, and said there have been additional discussions regarding potentially naming articles donated to the city, such as a park bench or a tree.
