All volunteers need to be drug tested, fingerprinted and background checked, being able to obtain a level 1 fingerprint clearance card. Those working with food or in the kitchen need to have a current food handler card. The city will cover the cost of the process.

Makes 4 servings

- 1 package (8 ounces) seitan, cubed
- 1/2 cup barbecue sauce, divided
- 1 red bell pepper, cut into 12 pieces
- green bell pepper, cut into 12 pieces
- 12 white or cremini mushrooms
- 1 zucchini, cut into 12 pieces
- 1. Place seitan in medium bowl. Add 1/4 cup barbecue sauce; stir to coat. Marinate in refrigerator 30 minutes. Soak four bamboo skewers in water 20 minutes.
