Becoming Age Verified at the Senior Enrichment Center

The Senior Enrichment Center is offering the issuance of an ID badge which will facilitate your entry to and use of Center programs and facilities. The badge would be picked up upon arrival and turned in at the end of your visit. Badges are issued without any cost to patrons.

After watching the video make sure you visit 2275 Trane Road to obtain your ID badge Monday - Friday between 8:00 am -3:50 pm.

WHAT TO BRING WHEN YOU VISIT:

- 1. Bring your picture ID along with current address
- 2. Bring your Emergency ID's phone number

WHAT TO EXPECT WHEN YOU ARRIVE:

- 1. Let the front desk know you have viewed the orientation and you are ready to get your ID badge. You may be asked a question about what you learned during the video.
- 2. You will receive a registration form to be filled out before you get your badge. Everything in yellow is required or no badge can be printed (see above on "what to bring").
- 3. You will get a copy of the new information to retain along with a map of the property.
- 4. When you complete the form, turn it in along with picture ID and current address.
- 5. A picture will be taken and your badge will be issued on the spot.



The Bullhead City Senior Enrichment Center provides an integrated system of services, resources, and opportunities to help people improve their lives through recreational, social services and health and wellness services. The Senior Enrichment Center offers a variety of activities and programs for seniors ages 50+. The programs are specially designed to allow every adult of any activity level to participate in a safe and inviting environment. The Center offers more than 50 weekly activities designed to support independence, promote lifelong learning and sustain a healthy and engaged lifestyle.

Senior Enrichment Center is also home to the Bullhead City Nutrition Center. The Nutrition Center provides meals for individuals 50+. Meal options include a continental breakfast and lunch. Continental breakfast is served Monday through Friday from 8:30 a.m. to 10:30 a.m. for \$2, or \$1 for coffee only. Lunch is available Monday-Friday from 11:30 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. A suggested donation of \$3 is requested for each meal for individuals 60+ or disabled with a statement of need from a physician. Individuals 50+ can get lunch for \$5.

If you are unable to attend in person, they also offer a home delivery meal program through Meals on Wheels-Bullhead City, AZ. Interested in learning more or signing up. Call 1-(800)782-1886 and leave a message with your name, phone number and interest in Meals on Wheels in Bullhead City, to start the qualification process .

Drivers or Delivery Persons: Work 1 day a week, 9 am-12 pm. Two (2) people go on various routes delivering meals using our fleet of vehicles Tue and Thurs.

Meal Pick Up Person: 1 hour a week M-F 8:30-9:30 am

Breakfast Servers: Work 1 day a week 8:15-10:45 am. Serving breakfast items from our continental breakfast menu. No cooking necessary!

Lunch Servers: Work 1 day a week 11:15 am −1:15 pm. Serving precooked meals in a congregate setting. Clean up and preparation for next day. No cooking necessary.

Wellness Check Callers: Work for 2 hours between 9 am -12 pm calling homebound clients on Monday or Friday. Read from a script and share a smile to make sure they are okay and ready for the next delivery.

Angels Essential Worker: Open our room and assist individuals with donated durable medical equipment. 10am -1 pm

Newsletter Delivery: Once a month deliver newsletters to pre-routed locations. Usually takes place on a Monday, Wednesday or Friday and with two (2) people takes about 4 hours

Community Store Worker: Watch over and track sales in the community store. Work 1 day a week 10 am-1 pm or 1-4 pm

Technology Savoy Helpers: Come in once a week for a two hours to help people with computers, phone tech, or tablets. 9-11am, 11am-1 pm or 1-3 pm

Volunteers must be 18 or older, able to pass a background check. Some positions require a level 1 fingerprint clearance card and drug screening. Kitchen Volunteers must take a food handlers course.

Consider these gratifying Thanksgiving Facts

Thanksgiving is a time to gather with family and friends and reflect on one's blessings. In anticipation of this holiday, here are some interesting facts about the Thanksgiving celebration.

American Thanksgiving is largely modeled on a 17th century harvest feast shared by the English settlers and the Wampanoag tribe.

The National Turkey Federation says around 45 million turkeys will be eaten on Thanksgiving, which equates to about 720 million pounds of turkey being consumed (with the average turkey size being 16 pounds).

The Butterball hotline answers roughly 100,000 calls every year on its turkey question hotline.

In 1953, the Swanson company overestimated the number of frozen turkeys it would sell for the holiday season by 26 tons. Rather than waste the meat, Swanson sliced it up, repackaged it and created the first frozen TV dinners.

Thanksgiving in America may be older than many recognize. While Thanksgiving is largely tied to the 17th century settlers, the National Parks Service says in 1565 Spanish settlers in St. Augustine (now Florida) celebrated by having a meal to which they invited the native Seloy tribe. The Spanish served pork stew, sea biscuits, red wine, and garbanzo beans. Some say the Seloy contributed turkey, venison and maize.



Thanksgiving didn't become a civic holiday until Abraham Lincoln made it one after the Civil War tragedy. Thanksgiving was declared a national holiday on October 20, 1864.

The Pilgrims did not refer to themselves as pilgrims. They used the word separatists as they were separating themselves from a larger belief system.

In addition to Canada and the United States, Grenada, Liberia, the Philippines, Saint Lucia, and the Netherlands celebrate their own versions of Thanksqiving.

Each year, the American president pardons a turkey from slaughter on Thanksgiving. This tradition dates back to when Abraham Lincoln's son was upset that his family's turkey that was going to be killed for Thanksgiving dinner.

According to the U.S. Calorie Control Council (CCC), an average American may consume 4,500 calories and 229 grams of fat on Thanksgiving Day.

The Macy's Thanksgiving Day Parade is an annual tradition. People line the parade route in New York City or tune in to watch the parade on television. It originated in 1924 and the famed balloons were added in 1927.
