NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Bullhead City, Arizona that said estimates of revenues and expenditures/expenses shown on the accompanying schedules A – G as now increased, reduced or changed by and the same are hereby adopted as the budget of the City of Bullhead City, Arizona for the fiscal year 2015-2016.
