# Civil Traffic Default/Suspension Fee:

The municipal court shall assess the defendant a default/suspension fee as set by the Mohave County Superior Court (currently \$50) for each default judgment entered in a civil traffic violation case upon failure to appear or failure to pay a civil sanction, unless such default judgment is set aside under Rule 28, Rules of Procedure in Civil Traffic Cases. Fees collected shall be deposited into the general fund of the City.

#### Warrant Fee:

The municipal court shall assess the defendant a warrant fee as set by the Mohave County Superior Court (currently \$50) for each warrant issued as a result of their failure to appear as required by court order or failure to comply as required by court order. Fees collected shall be deposited into the general fund of the City.

#### Order to Show Cause Fee (OSC):

The municipal court shall assess the defendant an OSC fee of \$50 for each OSC issued for failure to comply with probation or as required by court order. Fees collected shall be deposited into the general fund of the City.

#### Court Enhancement Fund:

The municipal court shall collect a court enhancement fee of \$10.00 as set by the Arizona Supreme Court. The court enhancement fee shall be used exclusively to enhance the technological, operational and security capabilities of the court. The enhancement fund shall be maintained by the addition of this fee, plus any required surcharges, on all fines, sanctions, assessments and diversion or probation programs, including defensive driving, domestic violence, and substance abuse counseling. Fees collected shall be deposited into a fund account designated by the City Treasurer for the purpose of receiving the court enhancement fee. Interest earned on fund monies shall be deposited into the fund. The court enhancement fund shall be used at the sole discretion of the City Magistrate to the limit of available account balance, as appropriated by the City Council. The City Magistrate may use court enhancement funds in conjunction with any other court or courts in any common projects, programs, or uses which may benefit the Municipal Court's operations.

#### Court Appointed Counsel Fee:

In addition to court appointed attorney reimbursement costs, the court may impose an administrative assessment fee not to exceed \$25 used to defray the costs of court appointed counsel for indigent defendants. Fees collected shall be deposited into the general fund of the City.

#### Collection Agency Fee:

In the event the court engages a collection agency licensed pursuant to Title 32, Chapter 9, Article 2, Arizona Revised Statutes, to collect monies due the court for fines, sanctions, restitution, surcharges, assessments, penalties, bonds or other fees, the defendant shall be liable for all costs of collection, including fees charged by the agency and attorney's fees.

#### Waiver of Fees:

The court may waive all or part of the above fees when it would be in the best interests of justice, such as causing an undue hardship on the defendant, the defendant has previously been found to be indigent by the court, or the defendant has presented a reasonable explanation for missed appointments with the court or another agency, except fees charged by a collection agency may not be waived if any collection agreement with the court so provides.

- \*\*Victims of crimes, including domestic violence, will not be charged a fee for a single copy of the police incident report prepared in connection with the police department's investigation of the offense.
  - A. Representative examples of police incident reports that will be provided at no charge to victims of crime include, but are not intended to be limited by enumeration to, such offenses as homicide, rape, robbery, burglary, assault, larceny/theft, motor vehicle accidents, motor vehicle theft, domestic violence and arson, among others.
  - B. Each victim of a crime will be entitled to a single copy of the police incident report prepared by the police department in connection with its investigation of the offense. The victim may request the police report in writing or alternatively in person through the Bullhead City Police Department. In addition to requesting the report in person or in writing, the victim may request a report through an individual authorized by written power of attorney to make the request on behalf of the victim or through a licensed attorney at law who represents the victim.
  - C. Requests for victims of crimes for additional copies of police incident reports relating to the same offense shall be subject to adopted and approved City fees.
